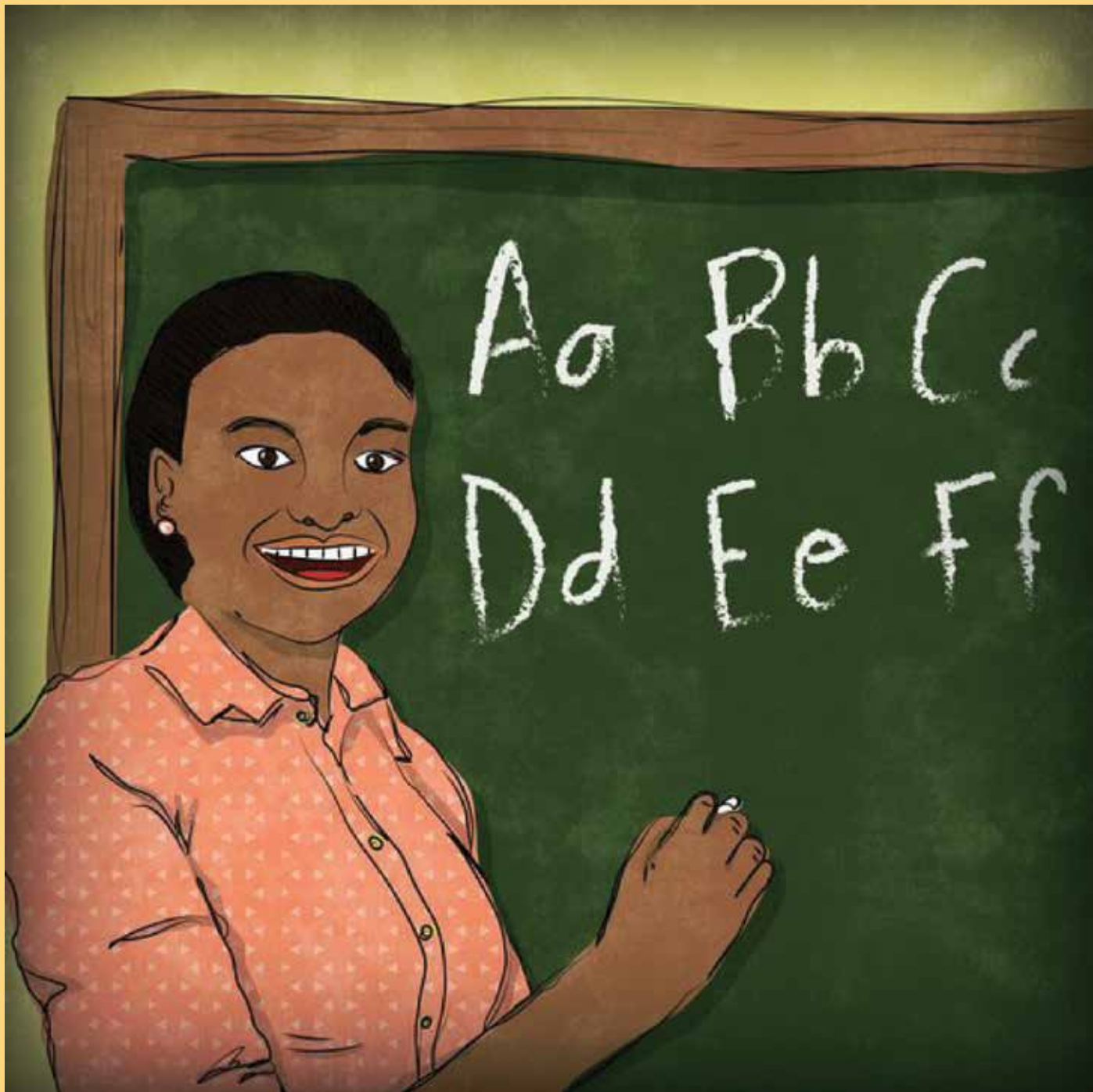

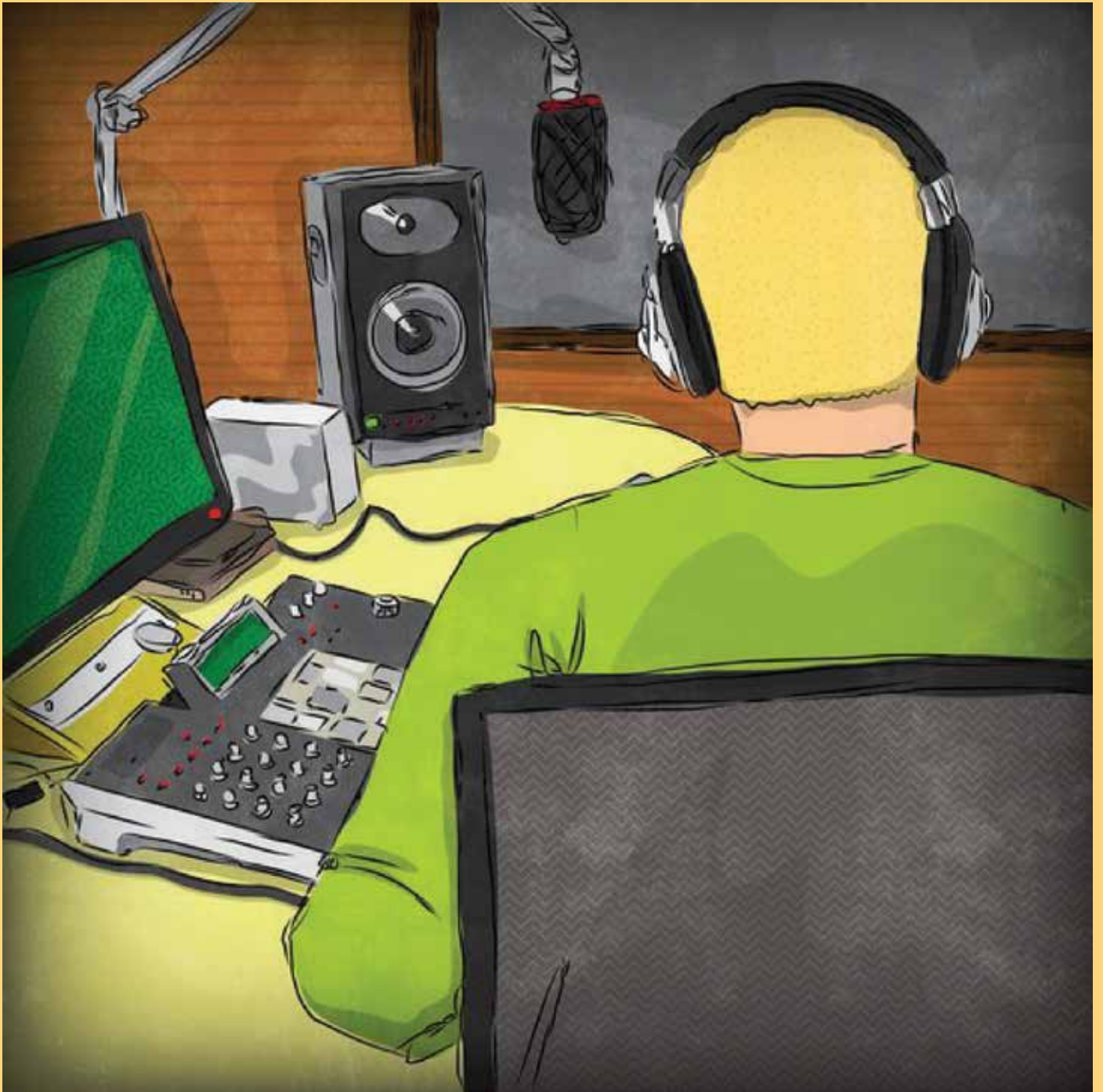




This is Agnes. She
is my teacher.



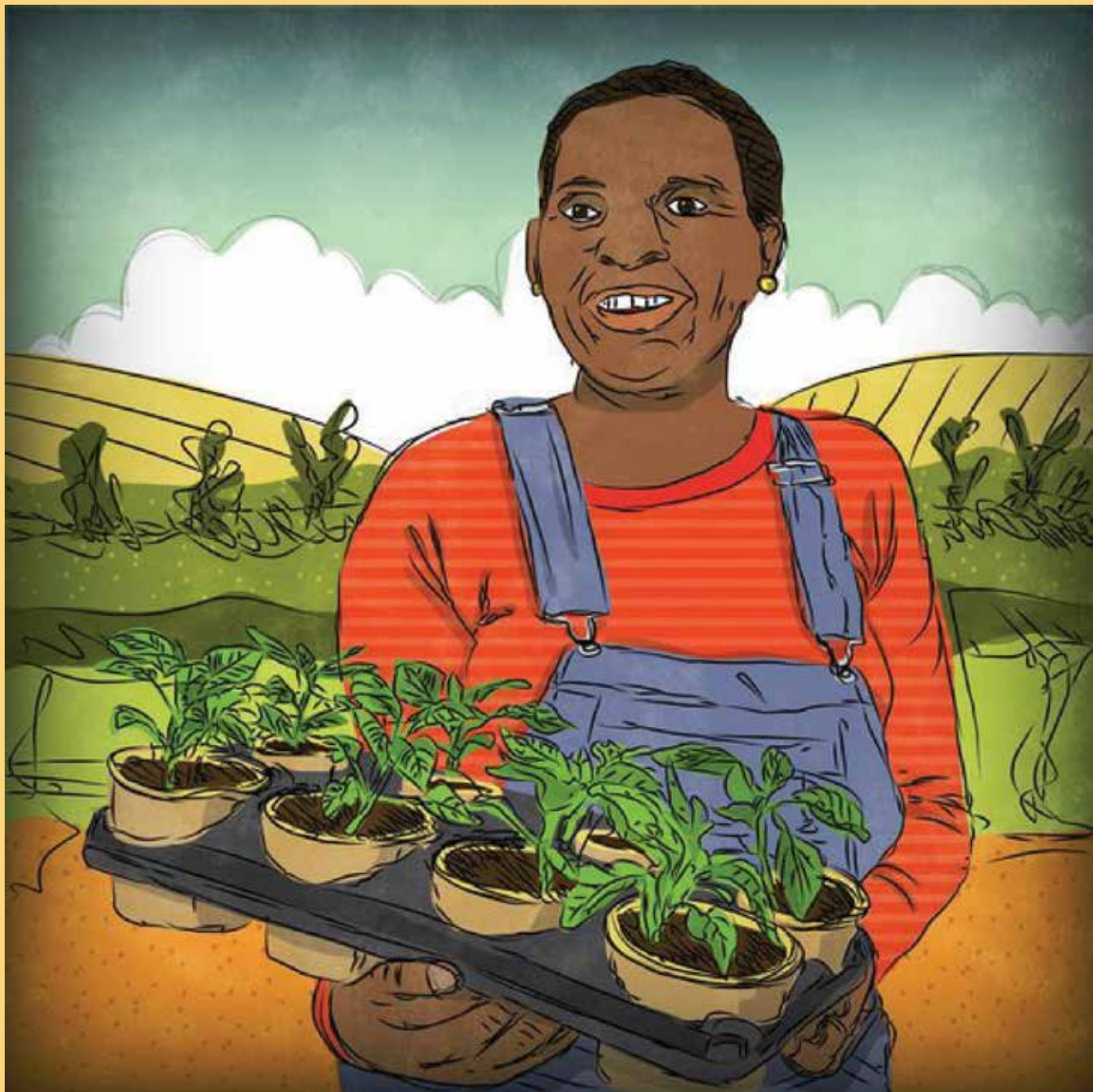
Agnes uses
crutches to walk.



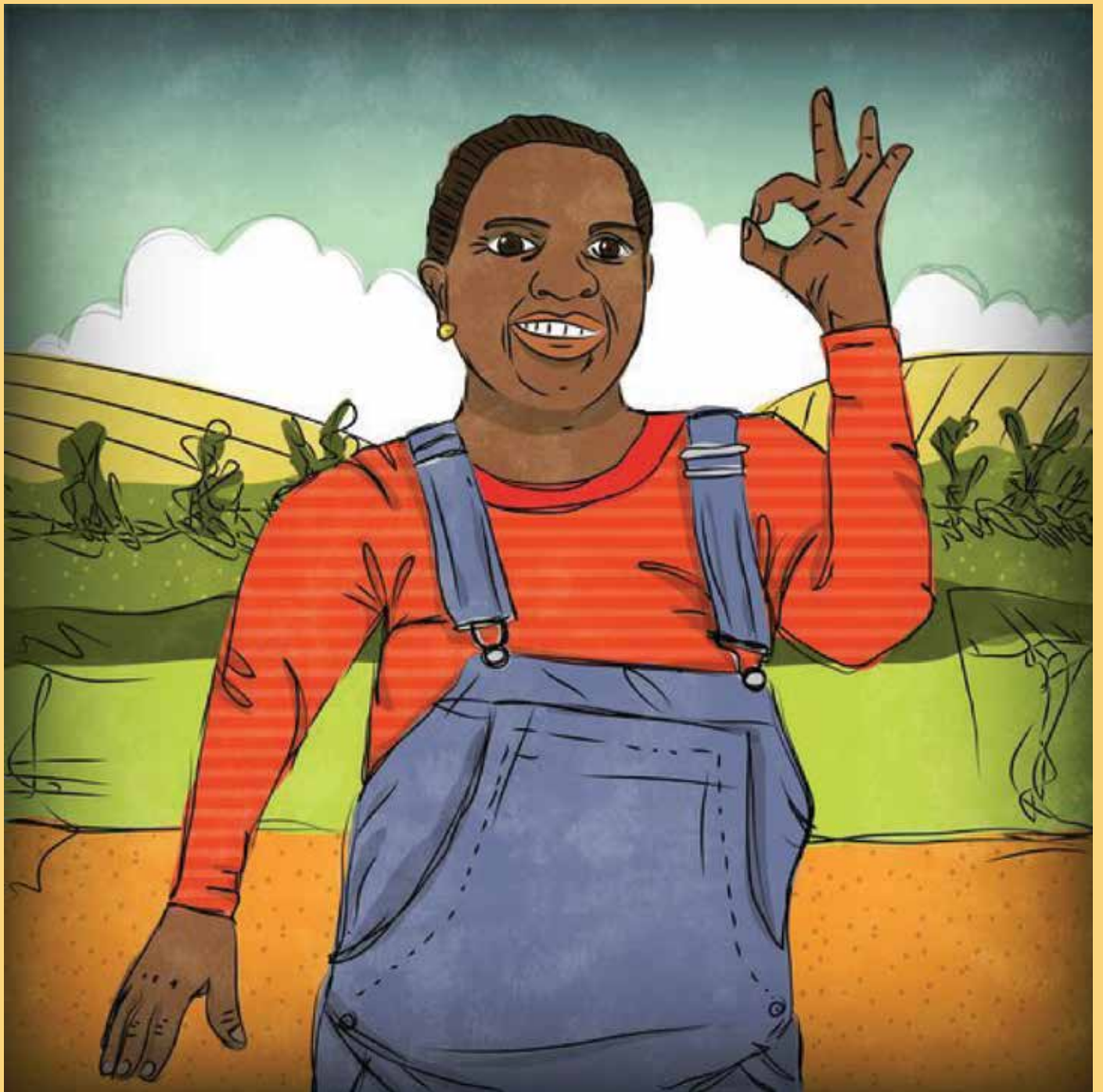
This is Metobo. He

radio DJ.



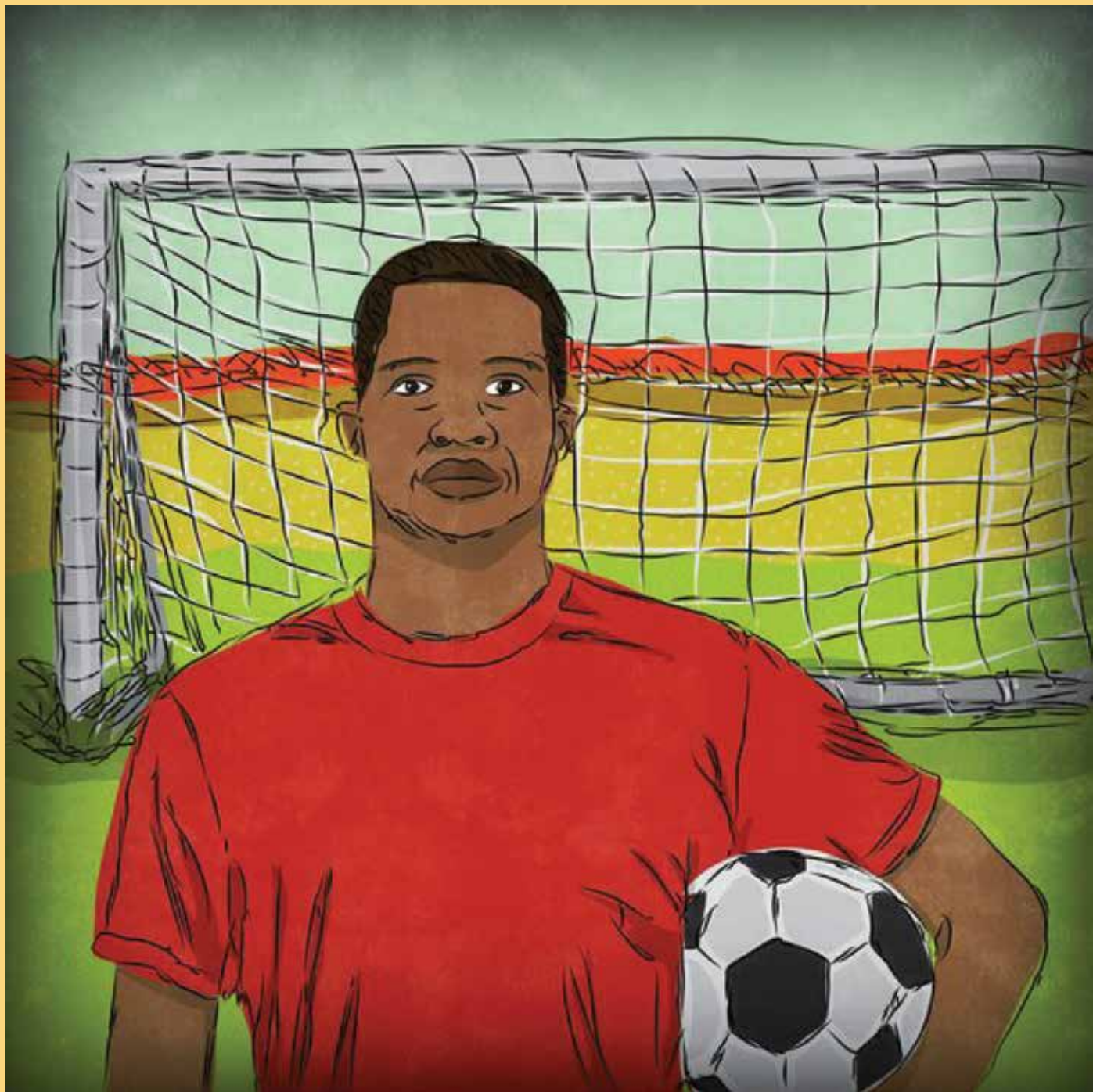
Metobo has
